ABSTRACT:

In the contemporary implant dentistry the soft tissues management is always more and more important, since bone tissue augmentation procedures are highly predictable. Peri-implant soft tissues play an important role not only in order to achieve an optimal esthetic outcome but, to the current knowledge, an adequate thickness of the peri-implant seal is a prerequisite for the long-term maintenance of the marginal bone levels.
